Finally, CANSPEI has received \$30,000 from the NS Department of Communities, Culture, Heritage and Tourism for each of the last five years through their Provincial Recreation Organization grant. We have recently been informed our 2022 allotment will be received shortly. This \$30,000 per year funding for five years was no small feat. We wish to inform you that we have applied again for this block funding for 2023-2028. Again this application process was very cumbersome and detailed however, we are hopeful we will receive some level of funding again.
